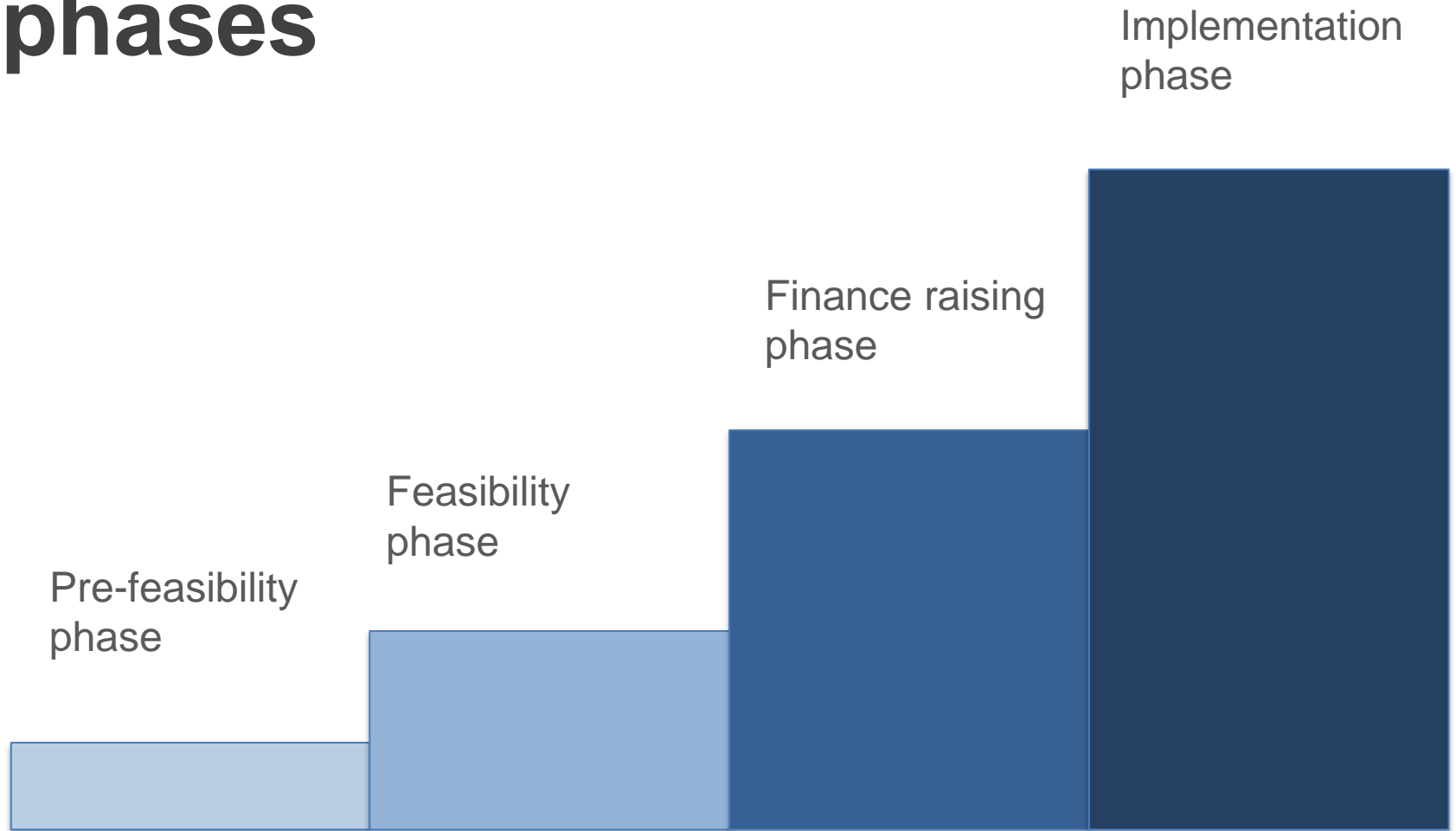

Role of climate finance in early stage project preparation

Risk sharing agreement between Belgian Government and Carbon Africa

- MoU with Associação Moçambicana de Reciclagem (AMOR)
- Development of Business Plan
- Establishment of National Task Force
- Raise funding from Africa Enterprise Challenge Fund
- MoU with Municipality of Beira
- Establishment of joint venture company between AMOR and Carbon Africa



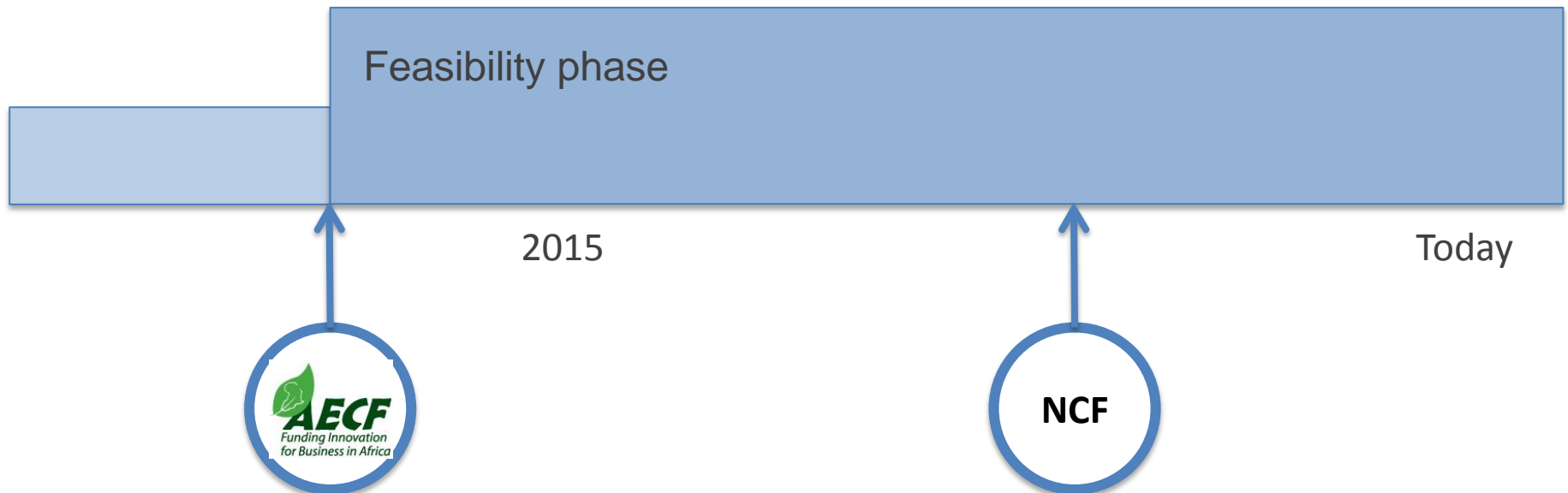
Key lessons learned

1. Risk sharing for early-stage project preparation
2. Public-private collaboration from an early stage
 - Ensure that projects are in line with national priorities
 - Provide platform to enhance regulatory environment
 - Create common vision and identify win-win situations
 - Collaboration on raising international climate finance

Role of climate finance in early stage project preparation

Grant Agreement with Nordic Climate Facility

1. Prepare national NAMA financing proposals
2. Implement a pilot Recycling Center in Beira
3. Feasibility studies and permitting
4. Stakeholder engagement



Conclusions

1. International climate finance has played a critical role
2. More attention should be paid to leveraging entrepreneurship for early-stage project preparation
3. Public-private collaboration is key for the successful development and implementation
