Warsaw focus points

In Warsaw, Business urges governments to:

- provide clarity on scope and legal form of the 2015 agreement
- enable a global level playing field ... pursuing market-based approaches.
- ensure that Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) are fully protected.
- maintain, improve and expand Clean Development Mechanism (CDM). Re-initiating the Joint Implementation mechanism after 2012.
- ensure that policies and instruments in the field of climate technology and finance contribute to a favourable business environment.
